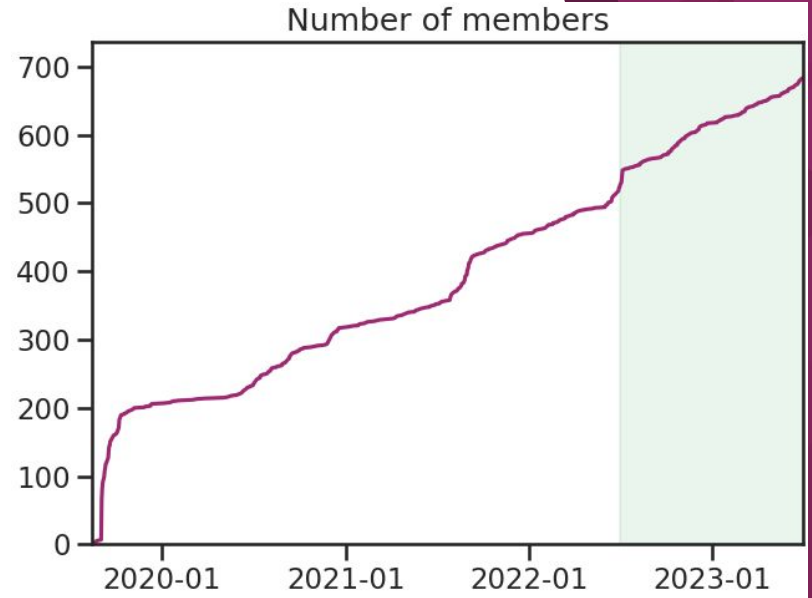
- ▶ 5 events supported with funding (of 7 requests)

 - ▷ Festival of the Hidden REF



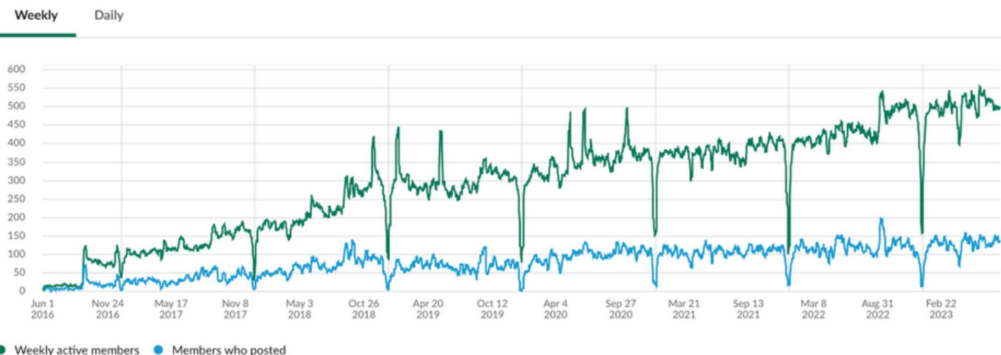

Treasurer's Report

Financial year: 01 July 2022 to 30 June 2023

Income: **£165,348.44**

- ▶ Mostly conference & memberships

Expenses: **£104,294.80**

- ▶ Conference costs, infrastructure, bank fees, events sponsorship, consulting, ...

Treasurer's Report

Surplus ~£61k mainly due to:

- ▶ cautious approach to the 2022 conference
- ▶ earlier ticket sales for 2023 conference

Accounts are subject to independent examination by our accountants.
